



The Indianola City Council has removed the mask mandate for Indianola and replaced it with a mask recommendation. Beginning Monday, November 29, 2021, the wearing of masks during the school day will be a recommendation. It will be optional for all students and allow parents to make the decision for their students. Masks will continue to be supplied by the school but will be optional for all students. Parents and students should be aware that mask wearing and vaccination status affect both the quarantine and length of quarantine for students exposed to Covid. Of course this policy is subject to change depending on the city council, rising infection rates, or other circumstances.
